There is no election of a Vice President this year, but there will be in 2023.

Conference in 2023

Planning for the next regional conference is starting to gear up. A revised MOU has been signed with the Millenium Copthorne Waitangi in the Bay of Islands, New Zealand. The conference will be called Biometrics in the Bay of Island and will be held jointly with SEEM. James Curran and Simon Urbanek has a very preliminary website up and running (<u>http://biometricsboi.nz</u>) and this will be revised as we progress. The Conference LOC consists of James Curran, Vanessa Cave, David Baird and Mathew Schofield (SEEM), and the Conference SPC: Esther Meenken and Ben Stevenson (SEEM)

Membership

An increase of USD5 (from USD60 to USD65) by the society has meant that the region needs increase its own fees. Our treasurer, Ian Renner looked at two models – an AUD10 increase and an AUD20 increase. The council felt that the latter keeps the society's finances in a more stable place, and thus voted for an increase. It is highly likely that we will have to revisit this decision in 1-2 years as further increases have been signaled by the society.

Motion Vanessa Cave "that membership fees increase to \$120 and \$60 for senior retirees" - approved

Other business

David Baird thanked Vanessa Cave for her service as President, and welcomed James Curran as the new President.
